Versatile and able to transform

We have had the outdoor climbing equipment for over three months now, and I can confirm that it is still incredibly popular among the children. Due to its versatility and ability to transform into four different configurations, the children are constantly engaged, and their creativity knows no bounds.

Quick and easy setup

Practitioners have mentioned how quick and easy it is to change the setup, and staff have praised the quality of the climbing frame.

Quality resource that is safe and durable

Initially, there were concerns about the climbing frame being susceptible to rot or damage in the outdoor environment. However, staff have been pleasantly surprised by how weather-resistant it is. Not only is the climbing frame durable, but it has also proven to be safe in all weathers; it does not become slippery in the rain or uncomfortably hot in the sun.

Enhances outdoor play and opportunities for physical development

The climbing frame has enhanced children's outdoor learning experiences in various ways. It has helped them develop physical skills such as gross motor skills, hand-eye coordination, balance, upper and lower body strength, as well as spatial awareness. The children adore counting down and jumping from the frame onto safety mats.

Other areas of learning impacted

This has not only supported the children's physical development but has also improved their personal, social, emotional, communication, language, and even maths skills. The equipment has not just been a climbing frame; it has also taken on various imaginative roles like a pirate ship, bus, and ice cream shop.



Children have enjoyed using it as a ramp for their cars or even as a paint easel, which wiped away easily without leaving any stains. Both staff and children highly recommend introducing this product, but it's worth noting that having an even floor space is important. In our garden, with its slight unevenness, there are small gaps between the equipment.
