I have been using Sound Lights in the classroom daily with my PMLD Complex Disability group for about a year now with great success. They are particularly useful when combined with printed off symbols which we place behind the clear screen to support the pre verbal students in being able to 'see', 'hear' and 'touch' the symbols. Each sound will be explored on a rolling program. We are presently using the symbols 'sit', 'more' and 'finish'.

The sound lights are a really useful size, as they are small enough to sit on a resource bookshelf, and on students' tables without being too big and getting in the way.

The sound lights are incredibly user friendly and as a result teaching and support staff can access them easily and can quickly and efficiently change the symbol and recording sound if needed.

I like the fact that the buttons light up green when pressed. The students' respond to this, knowing that they have done the correct thing as 'green' is a positive colour and means 'go'.

The batteries are easy to replace as they are common battery types.
