
### Speaking & Listening Skills with



# Ideas



### At Home

Kitt can be sent home with different recordings, videos or pictures for children to look at, share and listen to while at home. These could be anything from videos from school, messages from teachers, audiobooks, homework instructions or praise and celebration videos. This is great for supporting transition or for helping to bridge the gap between school and home.

### 2 Kitt Out and About

Take Kitt on excursions or to the playground and children can record themselves doing dances, talking about where they are visiting, or use Kitt as a playground companion for those who struggle with play times.

# **3** Capturing Learning

Kitt can take pictures or videos of work done in the classroom or at home which is ideal for evidencing work not done in books. For example, groups could record their presentations for playback on the computer if they are too shy to present live, or children could record themselves reading aloud at home.

# 4 Audiobooks

Children can listen to an audio story on Kitt. They can read along if they have the book too. They could then record their own version of the story back onto Kitt. You can build up an audio library of your class stories and share them onto other Kitt's.
