



What is Kitt?

Kitt is a versatile, non-moving robot with embedded microphone, camera, and speaker system. He does not need additional devices or the internet to work and can therefore support learning anywhere.

Kitt is not intended to be a complex ICT tool but rather a simple device that can be used by any child of primary age and above, in all areas of the curriculum and at home.



LEARNING AND ASSESSMENT WITH KITT



RECORD VIDEO, AUDIO OR IMAGES

Resources can be recorded by Kitt to help differentiate and support children's learning, such as checklists, modelled examples or reminders.





CHILDREN USE KITT TO ACCESS RESOURCES

Children can use Kitt, at school or at home, to access the files as many times as needed which helps to improve the quantity and quality of practice.



SUPPORTING INDEPENDENT LEARNING

Kitt supports children to experience success without needing to ask an adult for help. Children's self-esteem and confidence will grow and adult's time can be used more effectively in the classroom.



ASSESS AND INFORM NEXT STEPS

Teachers can then review children's learning captured using Kitt to inform assessment and plan for next steps.

Having found this independence, children can also use Kitt to upload, create and capture their own learning.
