
Cities of the World Mat Activity Ideas

You could adapt the activities to use with other robots, such as Bee-Bot or Blue-Bot.





Flying the Flag


The aim of this game is to help children to learn the names of cities around the world and match them to their flags.



Activity:

- Unplugged Activity Discuss the places and flags which the children recognise. You may wish to research ones which children are not familiar with.
- Prepare the small version of the mat and laminate for the teams playing.
- Working in groups, children take it in turns to challenge the other team to program Loti to a city by describing its flag. E.g. this flag has the colour red, white and blue in it. The other team might program Loti to the UK flag.
 - If they are correct, they can mark the square off on their small versions of the mat and they gain a point.
- If they are incorrect then on their next turn the other team must describe the same flag but with a different description e.g. the colours are in columns and blue is the first one.
 - The winner is the team with the most flags collected on their small mat.







Loti's City Breaks!

The aim of this game is to program Loti-Bot to visit as many cities on the mat as possible in a specified time limit.



Activity:

You may wish to create a Loti Bot passport and fact file about the places Loti-Bot has visited.

- Unplugged plan an around the world trip considering which cities Loti will visit and the sequence that she will visit them in according to location and travel time.
- Program Loti-Bot to go on her adventure. You may wish to change Loti's lights to represent the colours in the flag when she is visiting that city.
- To adjust the difficulty, include several cities in one visit.
