Chatter Board Pro



The Chatter Board Pro is an easy-to-use communication aid. It is great for seeing the relationship between oral and written/visual representations. Students of all ages will enjoy using the boards and those with speech and language difficulties will benefit from this versatile tool.

It is easy to create your own boards by changing the symbols on each tile or by creating your own grids using the grid generator (details on the next page). You can record the speech for each tile again and again so that when the image/icon is clicked the talk matches.



Ideal to be used inside or outside, the Chatter Board Pro will support pupils throughout the school across the curriculum.



Grid Generator

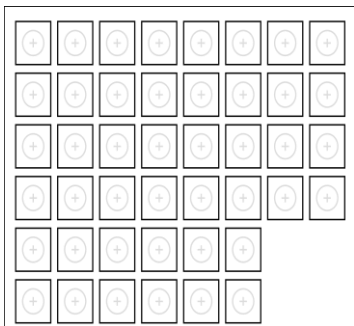

To add an **image** (preferably [square](#)), choose the mode [**insertion of images**] and click in a box.

To add **text**, choose the [**insert text**] mode, enter the text and click in a box.

To delete an image or text, click on the box.

Here are a few activity ideas. You will think of many more. Please share if you do. We'd love to hear them!

Make **vocabulary** learning fun! Add new words from text studying to model pronunciations. Add definitions to learn word meaning. Get pupils to record words learnt.

Learn a new **language** recording words in French, Italian, German, Spanish, etc. A picture- based activity will help pupils with new words and how to pronounce them.

Build a **sentence** using the recordable tiles or ask a **question** in chosen language to be answered by the listener.

Use the tiles to **recite** lines of **poems**. See if the pupils can order the lines correctly. Use to **tell stories** or to **order** instructions or events.

Reading Chatter Board

Record **key words** and phrases from book reading. Use the recordable tiles to ask and answer **comprehension** questions.

Learn **phonics** sounds and use the tiles to hear sounds and blend words for reading. Add common exception words and topic words.

More ideas....



Here are some more ideas that you can use and adapt.

Aid writing in other subjects using the tiles to learn **new topic words**. Great for encouraging pupils to explain their thinking in science.

Use for **number order, sequences and patterns**. Using dots or number icons the pupils can click on the tiles to order them.

Use the communication boards to **ask and answer scientific questions** and share predictions and explanations.

Use the Chatter Board to practise **multiplication and division facts** and to **recite the times tables**.

Make **word-problems** more accessible and fun in maths. Use the boards to make own **maths games**.

Use the tiles to **collect data** and to show information for charts, graphs and tables.



The Chatter Boards can be used in many areas across the curriculum. Create and save your own grids that you can use again and again.

A great way to introduce a topic. Use the grid for **topic words** in history and geography.

Use the grid to create a **sound board** in music. Pupils could collect sounds and experiment with ways to order them to create their own music.

Things to find

Use the grid for **questions** the pupils can find answers to, or they can use the board to store facts about a topic creating their own **fact book**.

Musical compositions Use icons of different instruments or sounds. Children match instruments to the sounds and create their own musical compositions.

Use the grid for a treasure map and give **coordinates** to be able to find the treasure.

Make a quiz to find out what the pupils have learnt about a topic. The children can record any other questions they still want to discover the answers to.

More ideas....



Everyone can enjoy using the Chatter Board Pro. It is a great communication device. You will discover many ways to use them.

Use as a **talk board** to share ideas, make connections and voice opinions.

Use as a **choice board** to support individuals who find it difficult to express themselves.

Use as a **calendar** with the days of the month on and record events and reminders of birthdays for each day.

Use as a **visual timetable** and use symbols to communicate what is happening throughout the day. Enhance pupil's speech to ask for the toilet, a drink, etc.
