# Exploring Maths



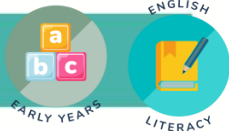
Find creative ways to explore maths.

- Record tally charts to count items collected or to keep scores in a game.
- Practise number formation on large or small scale.
- Create own calculations or simple mathematical problems for friends to solve.
- Explore shapes and go on a shape hunt.
- Record number facts and play number games.

# Super Signs



Create calming and welcoming indoor and outdoor spaces. Create an area for reflection.

Use as attractive, colourful, reusable signs around school. Leave clear messages to parents, carers and pupils. Reduce use of paper and record on the chalkboards. Great for developing communication skills.

- Express thoughts and emotions.
- Create a kindness wall with inspiring words and pictures.
- Leave messages for others. These might include directions, instructions, weather reports or rules for games playing.

# Outdoor Learning



Being outdoors provides unique experiences and inspires a sense of awe and wonder.

Naturally waterproof and even better at repelling water when used with liquid chalk. Versatile tools for hands-on learning, creativity and exploration in the outdoors.

- Use as a note board for budding nature detectives to record their findings and observations.
- Identify trees and plants.
- Connect with nature and learn about the natural world.
- Use as part of a Scavenger Hunt to record findings.



## PE & Playtimes

Great for all kinds of games. You can instantly amend content, add to it and erase what you no longer need. Use as signs in many games and play.



- Display rules for games.
