

## Activity Ideas for Glow Pebbles



*This set of 12 pebbles introduces children to cause and effect in a hands-on manner, sparking curiosity about light, colour, and tactile exploration through play.*

### Size and Colour

Children can arrange the Glow Pebbles from smallest to largest in a rainbow shape and colour.

### Treasure Hunt

Hide the pebbles and give the children clues as to where they can be found.

### Story Time

Children can use their imagination to bring stories to life and illustrate the characters emotions. Create small world scenes from stories such as magical planets and glowing forests. Encourage children to build stories and adventures around them.

### Reward Scheme

Give the pebbles to students to reward good behaviour and improve motivation.

### Learn Colour Names

Change the pebbles colour and ask children to name it. Alternatively, call out a colour. Can they find the right Pebble and pass it to you?

## ***Calm and Soothe***

The soft, glowing colours are perfect for sensory spaces or calming corners. Children can hold a Pebble, watch it change, will choose a colour that helps them feel settled.

## ***Stack and Balance***

Use the pebbles for a simple fine motor challenge. Children can stack and balance them, testing what fits where and how high they can go without toppling over.

## ***Sequences***

Create a colour pattern with the pebbles – red, blue, red, play - and see if the children can copy it or predict what comes next. You can add size too, mixing big and small pebbles for an added challenge.

## ***Cause and effect***

When children press the button to change the colour, they're learning that what they do makes something happen e.g. Pressing the button on the Pebble changes the colour. This simple action helps them understand cause and effect and is a fun first step towards early computing.

## ***Colour Emotions***

Children can use the pebbles to show how they feel, maybe blue means happy for one child and red means frustrated for another. The coloured glow pebbles can give them a visual way to share emotions without always needing words.
