

User Guide for TTS Clever Tiles

(LI10003)



Available in packs of 10 or 30, the Clever Tiles are able to record and playback sounds. Each tile has a wipe board surface so children can write or draw what is recorded. The tiles can be used individually or linked to other tiles so that the recordings can play back in a sequence. Perfect for blending sounds, creating sentences and ordering information. Here is a quick guide to get you started. We hope you find it useful.

What's in the Box?

- Clever Tiles (available in packs of 10 or 30)
- Requires 2x AAA batteries (not included)
- Quick Start Visual Guide



Make a Recording



- Move the slide switch on the underside of the tile to the REC position.
- Press the red record button on the top of the tile.
- A single beep will mean the recording is activated and you can then record your message. You can record up to 10 seconds per tile.
- Press the record button once more to end your recording.

Playback a Recorded Message

- Move the slide switch on the underside of the tile to the PLAY position.
- Press the green play button on the tile to hear the message played back.



Sequencing the Tiles

Now for the really clever part...

- Record a single sound, word or sentence onto each tile.
- Move the switch to the PLAY position on each tile.
- Connect the tiles together, ensuring they are all placed the same way, with the red record button at the top right and the green play button at the bottom left.
- Press the green play button on the first tile and listen to all the tiles playing back the message in sequence.



Benefits and Uses

There are many benefits to the Clever Tiles including being able to:

- ❖ Record your own words, sentences or phrases.
- ❖ Write on the dry-wipe surface to provide visual support.
- ❖ Choose to use the tiles individually or link the tiles together to sequence words, numbers, sentences or parts of a story.



The Clever Tiles can be used in a variety of ways across different areas of learning. They are perfect for supporting phonics, blending sounds, sequencing sentences, recording and ordering maths sentences or numbers, sequencing facts for a timeline, setting out tasks for the day, supporting language and much more.
