

# User Guide Recordable Magnifying Glasses (SC00553)



A colourful set of 6 chunky recordable magnifying glasses, perfect for investigating and looking closely at items. With dual lens magnification and a recordable function of up to 30 seconds children can focus on their observations whilst capturing auditory commentary and making discoveries.

Here is a quick guide to get you started. We hope you find it useful.

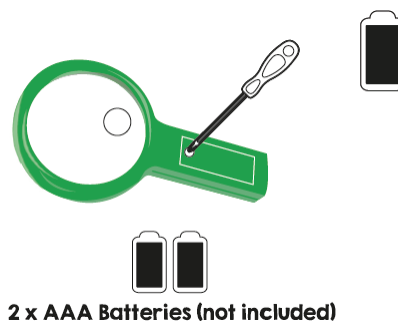
## What's in the box?

- 6x recordable magnifying glasses and Quick Start Guide.

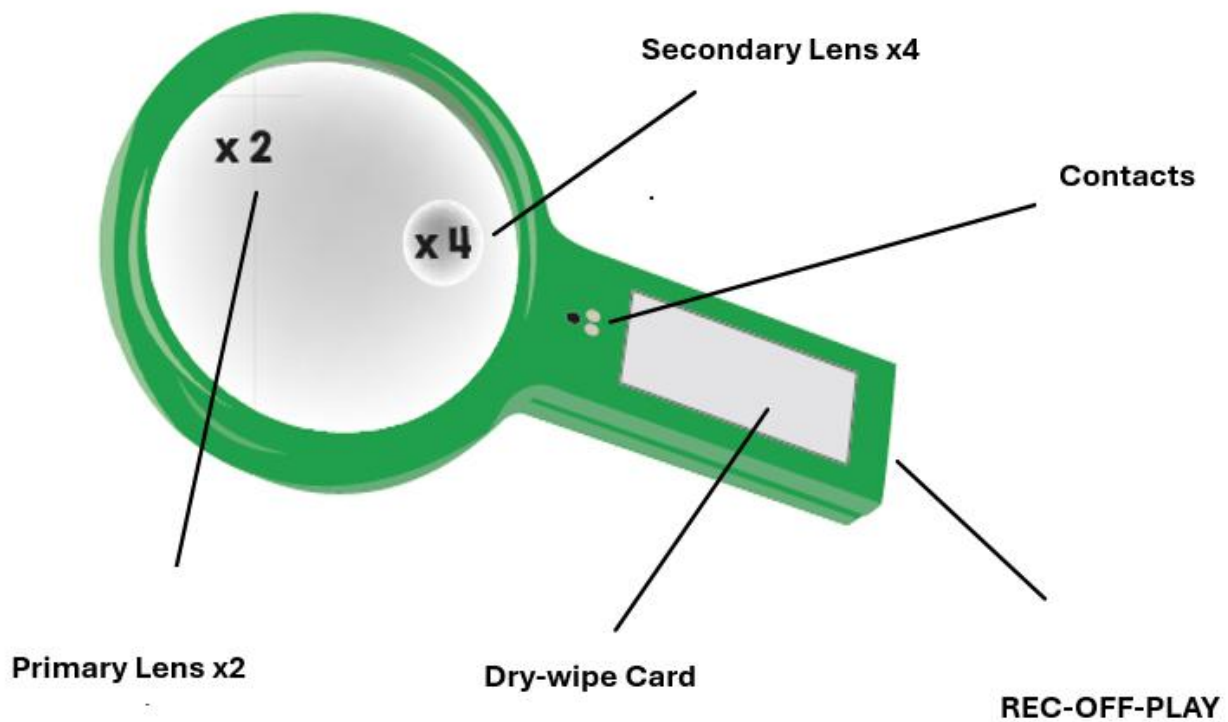


## Getting started

- Insert 2x AAA batteries (not included) into the magnifying glasses before use.
- Write names on the wipeable insert on the handle for easy identification of whose recording it is after the magnifiers have been used.
- Show how to use the magnifiers by bringing the magnifier close to the eye and moving so that the object comes into focus. Teach never to look directly at the sun with the magnifying glass as this can cause eye damage.
- Demonstrate how to record a message and play back the recording. Get to know the magnifying glass, see diagram below.



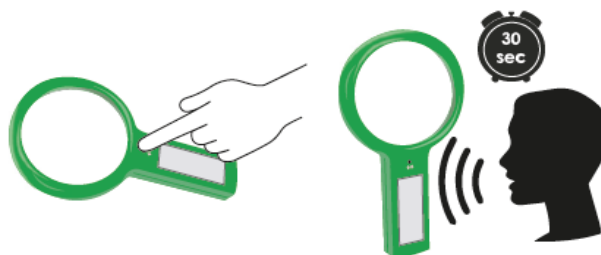
*Remove battery cover with a crosshead screwdriver and fit batteries correctly. Replace the cover and tighten screw. Batteries should be fitted by an adult and all used batteries disposed of in the correct manner.*



## To record

The cool thing about these magnifying glasses is the recording feature. You are able to record observations and notes in real time without having to put them down to write notes.

- Move slide switch to record (REC).
- Touch the contacts once to begin recording.
- After the beep speak for up to 30 seconds.
- Touch the contacts for a second time to end the recording. The magnifying glass will beep twice once you have finished your recording.
- Subsequent recordings will record over the previous recordings.



## To playback

- Move the slide switch to PLAY.
- Touch the contacts once to begin playback.
- Listen to the recording.
- Touch the contacts again to stop playback.

## Clean/Care

Ensure the magnifier is switched off before cleaning and after use to reserve battery life. Wipe gently with a clean damp cloth and dry thoroughly. Do not allow the product to come into contact with water or other liquids during play as this resource is not waterproof.

**The See and Speak Recordable Magnifying Glasses will help to develop focus, encourage observations, promote language and create curiosity. There are many fun activities to enjoy with the magnifiers. Here are a few ideas to get you started:**

- **What is it?** – Look closely at items, describe what you see and provide a short commentary on what you have found. Create a magnification station to observe and learn.
- **Treasure hunt/Historical dig** – Search for hidden items and look closely to notice details and patterns. Record information about what you have found and then use reference books to discover more information.
- **Discovery walk** – Be nature detectives and see what you can discover. Look out for certain colours, find where the minibeasts are hiding and notice patterns on leaves.
- **Be scientists** – Observe science experiments close up. Record a short explanation of what you can see to help remember details when writing up a science report.
- **Map work** – Look at maps through the magnifiers and see what you can find. Use the recordable function to give coordinates and directions for others to find features.
- **Letter/Word hunter** – Search through a range of content such as text on cereal boxes, recipes, newspaper reports, etc to find specific letters, words or phrases. Use the recordable feature to read words, sentences or paragraphs where they have been found.
