

User Guide See and Speak Recordable Binoculars (SC00748)



Lightweight easy-to-use binoculars that are robust and easy to hold. The binoculars have 4x magnification and 30 seconds voice recording time. Ideal for recording observations without having to put the binoculars down to make notes.

Here is a quick guide to get you started. We hope you find it useful.

What's in the box?

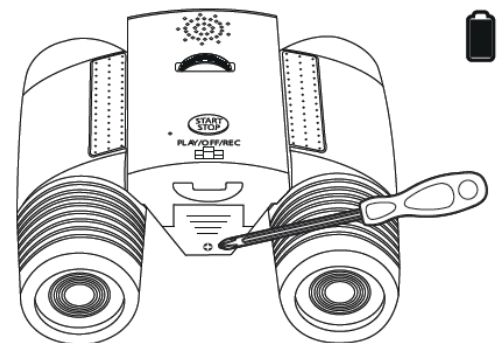
- 6x See and Speak Binoculars
- Strap for each binocular to wear around the neck

Getting started

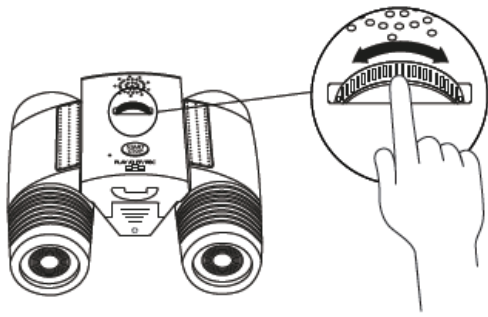
Insert 2x AAA batteries (not included) into the binoculars before use. Put on the straps so that the binoculars can be worn around the neck.

Learn that to magnify is to make something look bigger.

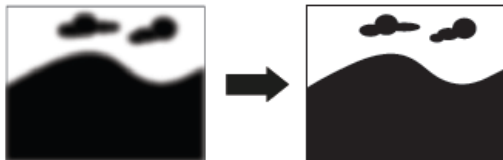
Start by finding a stationary object and then bring the binoculars up to the eyes with both hands, thumbs below and fingers above. Keep looking at the target. Adjust the width and use the focus wheel to get a comfortable and unblurred magnified view.



2 x AAA Batteries (not included)



Fine tune the focus to make the image clearer and crisper.



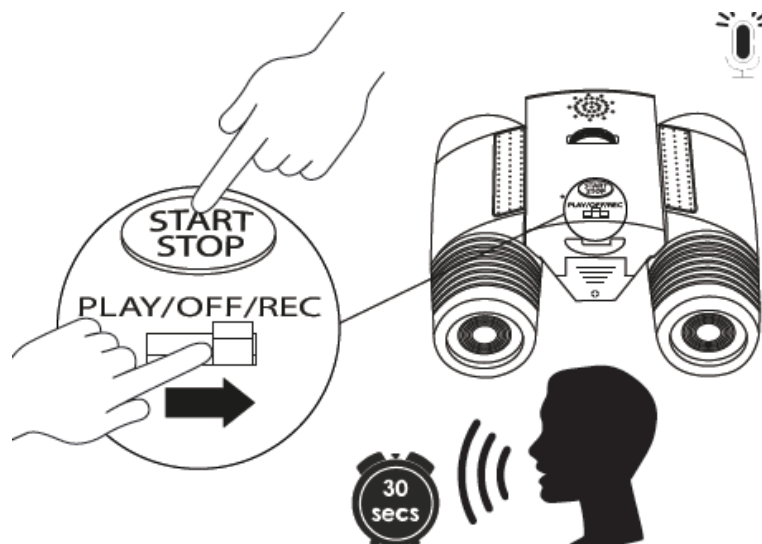
Practise looking at different things. Use the binoculars around home, school, classroom and outside to see what you can see.

NB For safety avoid walking while looking through the binoculars.

To record

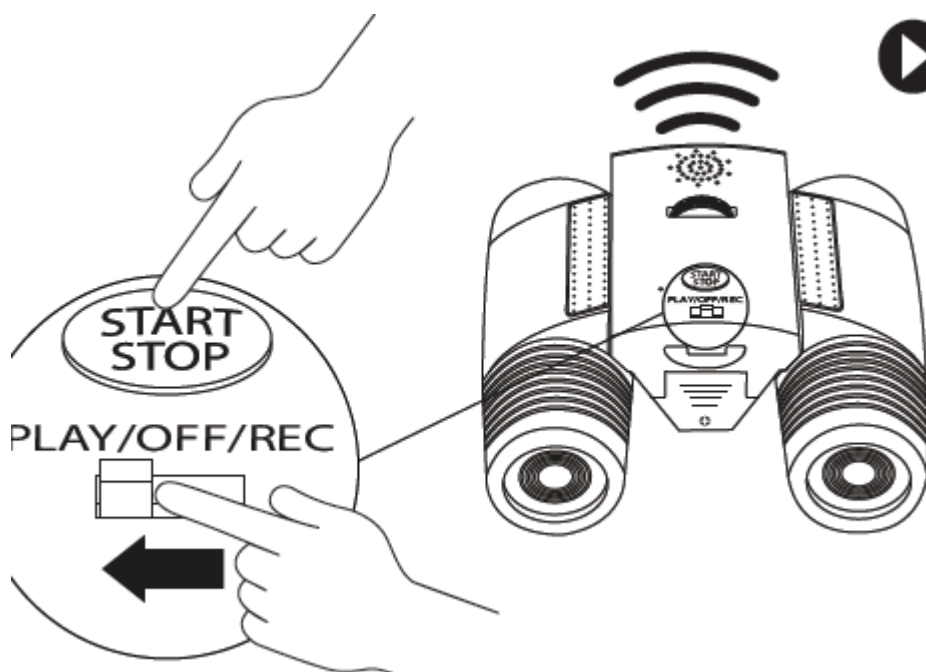
The cool thing about these binoculars is the recording feature. You are able to record observations and notes in real time without having to put down the binoculars.

- Switch slide to Record (REC)
- Press START button to capture up to 30 seconds of audio. Only one recording can be made at one time.
- After recording press STOP to finish.



To play back voice recording

Simply switch to PLAY and press START to hear your recording.



Clean/Care

Keep the binoculars clean by gently blowing away any loose dirt and wiping carefully with a damp soft cloth. If very dirty use a mild household cleaner or water and soap solution and use a clean microfiber cloth on the lens.

The binoculars help to develop focus, encourages observations, promotes language and creates curiosity. There are many fun activities to enjoy with the See and Speak Binoculars. Here are a few to get you started:

- **Nature Scavenger Hunt-** Find leaves, different coloured flowers, animal tracks.
- **I Spy-** Set a challenge of finding something red, something that is shiny. The children look for it, record when they see something and report back what they have found to the group.
- **Explorer Missions-** Pretend to be spies, safari guides, astronauts, or explorers. Record what you see and talk about your observations.
- **Nature Journal-** Look at detail, pattern, identify colours, shapes and textures and describe what you see.

The main thing to remember is to have fun.
